at its fundamental level jungian psychotherapy also referred to as jungian analysis is a thorough analytical approach to talk therapy that seeks to bring balance and union between the conscious and unconscious parts of the mind created by swiss psychiatrist carl jung also known as carl gustav jung or cg jung in the first half of the web dec 22 2021 jungian

or image that is present in the collective unconscious of all human beings the psychic counterpart of instinct archetypes are thought to be the basis of many of the common themes and symbols that appear in stories myths and dreams across different web jung 1947 believes symbols from different cultures are often very similar because they have emerged from archetypes shared by the whole human race which are part of our collective unconscious for jung our primitive past becomes the basis of the human psyche directing and influencing present behavior web jungian
